Main content of your story goes within these pages.

Please be aware of the printing margins (shown, right, in purple/pink) when planning your illustrations; all manuscript content and relevant illustrative detail should remain within these. During the printing process some trimming will occur, along with the binding process, which could cause information too close to the spine or edges to be bound/trimmed and lost. Consider how the illustrations you request will flow with your text while remaining within these parameters.
